

## EDITORIAL

In an effort to encourage submission of manuscripts on hydrology and atmospheric chemistry to the *Journal of Applied Meteorology*, two new associate editors have been appointed. Professor Witold Krajewski of the University of Iowa will serve as associate editor for hydrology, and Dr. Jeremy Hales of Battelle Pacific Northwest Laboratory will serve as associate editor for atmospheric chemistry.

Two special issues in these applied research areas are planned. The manuscripts for the special issue on hydrology have passed through the review process and will be published early in the next volume year. The manuscripts for the special issue on atmospheric chemistry will be submitted following the AMS technical meeting on that topic in January 1993.

New manuscripts in these two areas should be submitted to the chief editor. As with other topics, we ask that the emphasis of the papers be on applications (e.g., analysis of data to develop new relationships, or testing of model predictions with observations). Manuscripts dealing with more theoretical topics should be submitted to the *Journal of the Atmospheric Sciences*, manuscripts dealing with analysis of long-term averages should be submitted to the *Journal of Climate*, and manuscripts dealing with instrumentation topics should be submitted to the *Journal of Atmospheric and Oceanic Technology*.
