Invitation to Contribute to Gal-Chen Memorial Issue

The Council of the American Meteorological Society has approved the publication of a special issue of the *Journal of Atmospheric Science* in memory of Professor Tzvi Gal-Chen, who was Co-chief Editor at the time of his death. Since Tzvi was noted for a broad approach to atmospheric science and contributed to a number of subspecialties, we open the issue to papers in all fields to which he contributed. These include, at least, numerical simulation methods and mesoscale applications, analysis and model assimilation of ground- and space-based remotely sensed data, climate dynamics, and boundary mixed-layer study.

We solicit and welcome contributions to the Gal-Chen Memorial issue. Douglas Lilly will be the editor of the issue. Either review or novel papers will be considered, and will be subject to normal review and editing procedures. If an author believes his/her work is relevant to Tzvi's interests and activities, even those not listed above, we will certainly consider it. We may also invite an author who does not mention the Gal-Chen issue to consider publication there. The editor will make the final selection of papers based on quality, relevance, and overall balance. Papers not selected will still be considered for regular issues. We plan to publish the issue in September 1996, which would have been the month of Tzvi's 55th birthday. This will require fairly strict attention to deadlines for authors, reviewers, editors, and publisher. Specifically, we will consider papers offered for the issue by 1 December 1995, but need to have the bulk of them well before that. First come, first considered.
