Special Issue on Coupled Ocean–Atmosphere Models

For the past several years, the *Monthly Weather Review* has encouraged the submission of papers pertaining to coupled ocean–atmosphere models. With the addition of a new editor, Dr. Mojib Latif, whose area of expertise lies in coupled ocean–atmosphere models and oceanography, the number of submissions in this area has greatly increased since the beginning of 1994.
