

CORRIGENDUM

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Collins et al. (2000) contains a typographical error in section 3 on p. 126. The sentence at the end of the second paragraph of section 3 should read as follows: "Using a maximum reflectivity of ≥ 30 dBZ to define the existence of a convective storm, the time from the development of cells N and S to the demise of the TC was ~ 100 min (1729–1909 UTC)." In the original paper, the number 10 was used instead of 100.
